The mission of Horses Offering Opportunities for the Future, Inc. (HOOF KY) is to connect at-risk, disadvantaged, and trauma-stricken youth to horses and let horses work their magic. Horses have the ability to touch the human spirit in ways not found in other relationships. They can break down emotional walls and barriers of distrust, isolation, and manipulation as the young participants interact with and take stewardship of the horses.

This human-equine interaction teaches respect, responsibility, discipline, and personal empowerment. These attributes prepare our HOOF KY participants to make positive choices that lead to productive and healthy life styles.

HORSES HELPING YOUTH

What do we provide?

HORSES! CARING INSTRUCTORS! EQUINE EDUCATION! TRUST! HOOF KY in partnership with the Louisville Equestrian Center has developed weekly summer Equine Academies that teach riding, equine care, equine physiology/psychology, and barn management in a safe and controlled environment. Participants are taught by ARIA certified instructors and trained counselors who provide equine expertise and build caring, pro-social relationships with each young person. Instructors (and the horses) expect participants to work, give respect, be responsible, and believe that they can reach beyond themselves.

Why do we provide it?

Today young people are challenged to make healthy decisions in a culture laden with negative influences. Given the stressors of family disruption, violence, and substance abuse, many youth become distrustful and build walls protecting themselves from their environments. Many experience low self-image and a declining sense of personal empowerment, hiding behind the defenses of negative behaviors, manipulation, and isolation. HOOF KY understands that you can't fool a horse; consequently, our participants quickly learn that they must EARN the companionship of a horse which can positively impact their perspective and their life choices.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

HOOF KY partners with the Louisville Equestrian Center to provide:

- Oweekly summer Equine Academies each serving 30 at-risk youth ages 9-18. Academies run from 10 AM- 4:00 PM daily.
- OHorses, ponies, and their tack chosen for safety, manners and suitability to riders.
- **U**Safety riding helmets.
- OHighly qualified American Riding Instructors Association (ARIA) certified instructors who have years of experience working with all ages and abilities of riders.
- QRotating stations whereby participants learn riding, equine education and barn management. Competitive equine games and horse themed crafts are included.
- **O**Daily recorded individual participant competency evaluations.
- **O**Spacious indoor and outdoor arenas.
- **U**Logo T-shirts for each participant.
- **O**Awards Ceremony with certificates, individual pictures, and equine mementos.
- **O**Safe facility, First Aid trained counselors, and liability insurance.

Participants will:

- OFollow all counselor instructions to ensure safety for participants and horses.
- **U** Wear appropriate clothing, shoes, and safety gear.
- URefrain from aggression and bullying.
- **U**Learn to respect and care for other living creatures and mother earth.
