The mission of Horses Offering Opportunities for the Future, Inc. (HOOF KY) is to connect at-risk, disadvantaged, and trauma-stricken youth to horses and let horses work their magic. Horses have the ability to touch the human spirit in ways not found in other relationships. They can break down emotional walls and barriers of distrust, isolation, and manipulation as the young participants interact with and take stewardship of the horses.

This human-equine interaction teaches respect, responsibility, discipline, and personal empowerment. These attributes prepare our HOOF KY participants to make positive choices that lead to productive and healthy life styles.

WHAT DO WE PROVIDE?

HORSES! CARING INSTRUCTORS! EQUINE EDUCATION! TRUST! HOOF KY in partnership with the Louisville Equestrian Center has developed weekly summer Equine Academies that teach riding, equine care, equine physiology/psychology, and barn management in a safe and controlled environment. Participants are taught by ARIA certified instructors and trained counselors who provide equine expertise and build caring, pro-social relationships with each young person. Instructors (and the horses) expect participants to work, give respect, be responsible, and believe that they can reach beyond themselves.

WHY DO WE PROVIDE IT?

Today young people are challenged to make healthy decisions in a culture laden with negative influences. Given the stressors of family disruption, violence, and substance abuse, many youth become distrustful and build walls protecting themselves from their environments. Many experience low self-image and a declining sense of personal empowerment, hiding behind the defenses of negative behaviors, manipulation, and isolation. HOOF KY understands that you can't fool a horse; consequently, our participants quickly learn that they must EARN the companionship of a horse which can positively impact their perspective and their life choices.

Academy Work-Out Classes will be judged solely on a Work-Out only—Riders will enter the arena and line-up and then will be called out individually to perform work-out. All riders entered in Work-Out class will perform individual work-out. Work-Out will be posted on Facebook page by July 1st.

Academy High Point Awards will be given out to each Academy division. Points will be tabulated for each rider entered in their 3 respective classes (Equitation, Pleasure and Work-Out). This will be similar to how the Hunter riders are given out awards at their shows.

Points are awarded for each placing in each of the rider's 3 respective classes, the rider with the highest points/score will be named High Point rider for their division. In both the WTC and the WT divisions, a High Point Award and Reserve High Point award will be awarded. For WTC there will be 14-17, 13 & under and Adult, High Point and Reserve High Point awards (for any ties, both riders will receive awards and recognition!). For the WT division, there will be High Point and Reserve High Point awards for the following divisions: 14-17, Adult, 11-13, 9-10, 7-8, and 6 & under.

Awards and recognition will be given out for the WTC High Point divisions at the secretary's desk within 30 minutes of the last WTC class (to give time for tabulation), and the WT High Point Awards will be given out at the secretary's desk within 30 minutes of the last WT class. There are no High Point Awards given for the lead line riders.

These High Point and Reserve High Point awards will not affect the schedule of the show, as they will be presented outside of the arena.

Academy classes will be split at 10 riders.
